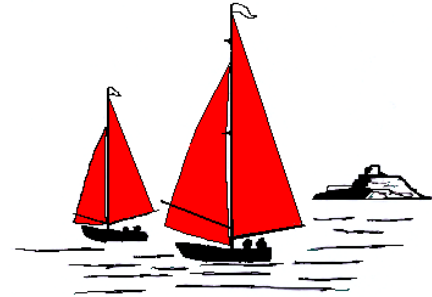

## HARBOUR DUES 2009

### Schedule of charges 1<sup>ST</sup> April 2009 – 31<sup>ST</sup> March 2010

The Harbour Company has again decided not to make any increases from previous years

The following scale of charges and dues as authorised by section 26 and 27 of the Harbour Act 1964 will be brought into force in Bembridge Harbour on the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 and payable by all vessels and Hovercraft entering using and leaving the harbour.

#### HARBOUR DUES – YACHTS/LEISURE VESSELS

Harbour Dues payable by all yachts/leisure vessels for the maintenance and conservation of the harbour.

#### Resident Pleasure Craft not Berthed on Bembridge Harbour Improvement Company Moorings

Annual dues:

up to 3.99 metres	under 12.9'	Exempt
4.00 metres to 5.99 metres	13' to 19.6'	£ 80.00 p.a.
6.00 metres to 7.49 metres	19.7' to 24.5'	£100.00 p.a.
7.50 metres to 8.99 metres	24.6' to 29.4'	£120.00 p.a.
Over 9 metres	Over 29.5'	£140.00 p.a.

#### Visiting yachts

Daily Rate	£2.50
Monthly Rate	£20.00

#### Notes:-

1. In the current year no Harbour Dues will be levied against the dinghy fleets and support vessels owned by the Bembridge Sailing Club and the Brading Haven Yacht Club.
2. Boatyards may compound their Harbour Dues on boats using Bembridge Harbour for access and exit only and going to Boatyards for repairs or permanent lay up.
3. Harbour Dues are exempt for all vessels paying mooring fees under contract to the Bembridge Harbour Improvements Company Limited.
4. ALL HARBOUR DUES INCLUDE VAT

#### Commercial Boats

#### Hovercraft

Harbour Dues in respect of amphibious hovercraft, sidewall hovercraft and other non-conventional hovercrafts.

For every vessel coming into the harbour:-

Rate - £1.00 per metre per entry (VAT zero rated).

#### Penalty rate on Non Payment

£5.00 per metre per day [including VAT]
